# 1. Objectives and contribution of Work Package 1

The general objective of the NET-TRACK project is to contribute to the realisation of the European Research Area in the field of surface transport by involving leading research Institutes of New Member States (NMS), Accession Countries (AC) and Western Balkan Countries (WBC) in current European research efforts.

This WP aims at laying the foundation for the work to be undertaken in the Work Packages 2 to 4 by:

- Identifying the potential partners in the NMS, AC and WBC countries
- Analyzing the characteristics of these partner institutions, in order to better target the activities of NET-TRACK
- Contacting these potential partners to verify and complete the inventory of priority activities and information needs

This goal is achieved by making an inventory of relevant research institutes to select the potential participants in the 2 Workshops prepared under WP2 and WP3. Although this inventory is not meant to give an exhaustive overview of the Transport research landscape, it is meant to serve broader purposes.

The survey that was held was instrumental for completing the inventory and identifying participants. However, it mainly served to identify the subjects of the first workshop on research management issues and to explore the interest on the second on 'soft' research infrastructures. The number and the form of the responses gathered did not allow any unambiguous analysis and conclusions.

The inventory of research institutes primarily meant to select the relevant potential participants in WP2 and WP3.

## 2. Working Methods

### 2.1. Task 1 - Inventory

The first task of this WP was to make an inventory of NMS, AC and WBC Institutions working in transport research.

This work mainly consisted in desk research. No physical meetings were necessary for the WP1, the work between the partners has been done mainly by emails and phone contacts. A significant effort was given during the first 4 months of the project.

The search turned to be an iterative process, because of a series of issues, mainly missing, ambiguous or outdated information. There was a need for cross-checking information and consulting experts within the ECTRI-network. The research landscape is rapidly changing in the targeted countries due to the political changes occurred in many of them in the past decennium. This has some influence on the stability of the information available.

The 18 following countries were targeted and have all been scanned:

- the 10 New member States: Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Slovakia and Slovenia<sup>1</sup>,
- the 2 Acceding countries: Romania and Bulgaria<sup>1</sup>,
- and the 6 Western Balkan Countries: Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia, FYROM, Montenegro and Serbia<sup>1</sup>.

This inventory was elaborated in the first stage by the use of:

- The existing databases like:
  - o Nordic Transport Forum (RECAP),
  - o Extr@web project (Transport Research Knowledge Centre)
  - o ERANET-Transport
- The knowledge of the ECTRI network
- The contacts in FP6 and COST
- The National Contact Points
- And some other networks such as SETREF, FERSI and FEHRL

The existing databases were exploited by the Workpackage participants. The Swedish colleague concentrated on the Baltic States and northern countries and the Czech Colleague on the new member States.

ECTRI used its own network and sent about 40 emails to its contacts in ECTRI, FP6 and COST to ask them to help in identifying the relevant Organisations in NMS, AC and WBC.

These three combined actions gave excellent results and allow drawing up a first version of the inventory which includes about 60 institutions.

From the first figures, the following features of the Institutions have been defined and looked at in order to refine the inventory:

- Name of the organisation
- Name of contact people
- E-mail
- Function
- Postal address
- Phone number
- Fax number

\* NMS included the 10 Countries which joined the EC on the 1st of May 2004 (phase 1 of enlargement to the CEECs "Central and Eastern European Countries" + Malta and Cyprus )

\* AC included Romania and Bulgaria (and Turkey)

\* 5 WBC included Serbia-Montenegro, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Albania, Former Yugoslav Republic Of Macedonia - FYROM- and Croatia

Further to the successive enlargement phase and also political change, the situation has evolved, and at the present time: the 10 NMS are now « Member States –MS- », the 2 AC, Rumania and Bulgaria, are the NMS from the 1st of January 2007 (Second phase of current enlargement). In addition, in the accession process, they are new candidates countries: FYROM from December 2005 (by Council decision of 30 Jan 2006) and Croatia -Start time June 2004 (Council decision from 20 Feb 2006) are now candidate countries. Regarding the WBC, Montenegro is independent from May 2006.

- Website
- Description of the Institute (Option), with for instance: thematic fields of activities in transport research, size of the organisation – number of researchers employed in Transport field –, legal statute
- Source of information

All these information were registered and gathered in an excel table (See Annex 3) and mailing lists were created (Annex 4). There was no limitation in the kind of Institutes included in the inventory i.e.: State-owned research Institutes, Universities, Faculties, Research Institutes owned by industry, private consultants.

The inventory has been updated at several occasions during the life of the project. First of all, with the outcomes of the survey analysis (see below). In addition, the two workshops were also the occasion to check the inventory; the participants were consulted to validate the information collected and advise on eventual missing institutions. These direct exchanges were very fruitful and valuable, in particular to update Polish, Slovakian, Slovenian and Macedonian list of institutions. Besides, the members of the workpackage also remained attentive of any new information on new institutions they could hear about, they checked regularly their sources of information and provided the workpackage leader with any new information. A particular updating effort was done before sending the invitation for the second workshop (on soft research infrastructures). This task was carried out mainly by desk research on the Internet in order to update the e-mail addresses and functions of people already identified in the inventory. During this phase of the work, 20 contacts have been updated and new contacts have been added.

At last, the first task was achieved by the identification of 90 relevant institutions working in transportation research in 18 countries. The inventory consists in one datasheet per country detailing the different identified institutions with some features (See annex 1).

## 2.2. Task 2 - Survey

The second task was to prepare and send a survey to targeted Institutions. This survey was aimed to explore the interest of the targeted Institutions and their needs/priorities in the workshops and to analyze the characteristics of these institutions, in order to better target the activities of NET-TRACK (as far as the objectives of WP2 and WP3 were concerned).

The survey and accompanying letter (Annex 2) were set up during the Months 4-5 (January-February 2006) by the members of the WP. The leader of WP2 and WP3 were consulted to give their opinion.

The Institutes to be approached were selected on the base of the inventory results. The main criteria of selection were the relevance of their research activities in transportation, their size and a fair geographical distribution. At least, very few Institutes were excluded from the selection. An address database of these Institutions was set up in excel format.

The accompanying/introductory letter and survey, together with the NET-TRACK and ECTRI leaflets, were sent to each selected institution both by regular post mail and by electronic mail on 6<sup>th</sup> of March 2006, with a deadline to answer set on 17<sup>th</sup> of March 2006.

On the 4<sup>th</sup> of April 2006, a reminder has been sent to each institution by electronic mail extending the deadline to answer to the survey to 14<sup>th</sup> of April 2006.

20 institutions on the 60 contacted answered to the survey. All of these showed a great interest in the project.

The answers to the survey have been analysed in depth. They helped to refine the inventory but also to define the goal and programme of the workshop and to identify the eventual speakers. The results of this analyse were released to WP2 and WP3 leaders.

## 3. Results

### 3.1. Inventory

As said previously, the 18 following countries were targeted and have all been scanned:

- the 10 New Member States (NMS): Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Slovakia and Slovenia<sup>2</sup>,
- the 2 Acceding Countries (AC): Romania and Bulgaria<sup>2</sup>,
- And the 6 Western Balkan Countries (WBC): Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia, FYROM, Montenegro and Serbia<sup>2</sup>.

The inventory resulted in a list of 90 research organisations, 60 of which were addressed by the survey. The others were not contacted due to varied reasons: non relevance of their research activities in transportation, limited size, for keeping a good balance in the geographical distribution.

As stated before, it is not intended to give a full overview of all organisations involved in transport research activities. There were 3 major criteria applied to include organisations in this list. These criteria became more apparent in the course of the inventory.

1. Focus: the core business has to be (scientific) research. e.g. marketing consultants, engineering businesses or policy units merely using research results were excluded.
2. Size: no sharp limits were established, but it was assumed that businesses with a staff under 10 persons would not carry out research management with any sophistication.
3. Content: the organisations should deal primarily with transport research. Institutes dealing in general terms with e. g. economic or environmental issues were not included.

The results of the inventory can be considered as satisfactory as it delivered a list of relevant research organisations covering most of the targeted countries and roughly corresponding with the size and importance of those countries.

For Malta no relevant partners could be identified. A Maltese representative in the Programme Committee of the Transport programme of FP6 informed us of the existence of a research institute dealing with tourism. It was considered being not relevant for our purpose.

Although the results are intuitively according to expectations, in few cases they were remarkable, e.g. the high number of consultancy firms in Estonia (due to their small size few were included) as compared with the Czech Republic or the number of (road) engineering firms in Romania. Such market analysis however, was beyond the scope of this inventory.

The fact sheets are presented in a standard format (See annex 1). They consist of 4 blocks:

- 1. General information:** here reference is made to internet sites including general information on transport research in the respective countries.
- 2. Potential participants:** here name, addresses, website (if available) and the status (participant in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> workshop/invited/not invited/Answered to survey) are stated. The potential participants are numbered.
- 3. Contact persons:** here the contact persons of the respective institutes (numbered accordingly) are indicated, including their function, e-mail address, phone and fax number (if available) .The contact persons are not necessarily the participants in the workshops.
- 4. About the participants:** here some succinct information on the institutes participating in the workshop (s) is given.

## 3.2. Survey

The survey aimed at getting contact with and feed-back from the above targeted organisations. It includes request of information regarding the organisation (name, address, contact person, main thematic field of activity in transport research, size of organisation), the interest in the two Workshops to be organised, and a list of 15 questions specifically related to the first workshop (8 on general aspect of research management, and 7 on European project related aspects).

This survey was sent with an accompanying letter (Annex 2), together with the NET-TRACK and ECTRI leaflets.

A total of 17 organisations answered to the survey (this information is provided in the fact sheets under the “details” section). All 17 showed an interest in the 2 workshops and answered on the above questions.

The surveys received were analysed in depth in order to define the goal and programme of the workshops. This information also helped to refine and complete the fact sheets of the inventory.
